Tuning Protocol: (Group A goes first, then switch and repeat with Group B)

3 minutes-Group A presents their work, Group B listens

2 minutes-Group B asks clarifying questions, Group A answers

- 3 minutes-Group B asks deep, probing questions to get Group A to think more deeply
- 3 minutes–Group B discusses Group A's project and thinks about suggestions (use sentence starters), Group A listens but doesn't talk, Group A should record notes about what they hear below

2 minutes-Group A responds to what they hear
